Enter one of the most useful Tamil resource sites on the web, the Tamil Electronic Library, www.geocities.com/Athens/5180/. Packed with ancient and modern texts, many in the downloadable Mylai Tamil font, this site is a wonderful addition to any Tamilphiles library. It was compiled by Dr. K. Kalyanasundaram of Switzerland and includes a large section on diverse Tamil fonts for the computer. It boasts many poems and songs of Tamil saints including Auvaiyar, Appar, Sundarar and Sambandar. The whole Tirukural is online, much of the Tirumurai and Tirumantiram, the Tirupugal, plus the poetic verses of Tiruvasagam and more.
